

Know these two definitions:

Focus—that point below the surface (in crust or mantle) where the earthquake originates, maximum depth is about 700 km, below that depth the material acts as a plastic.

Epicenter---start at the center of the earth and draw a line through the focus until it intersects the surface. That point on the surface is called the epicenter. You can stand on the epicenter.
