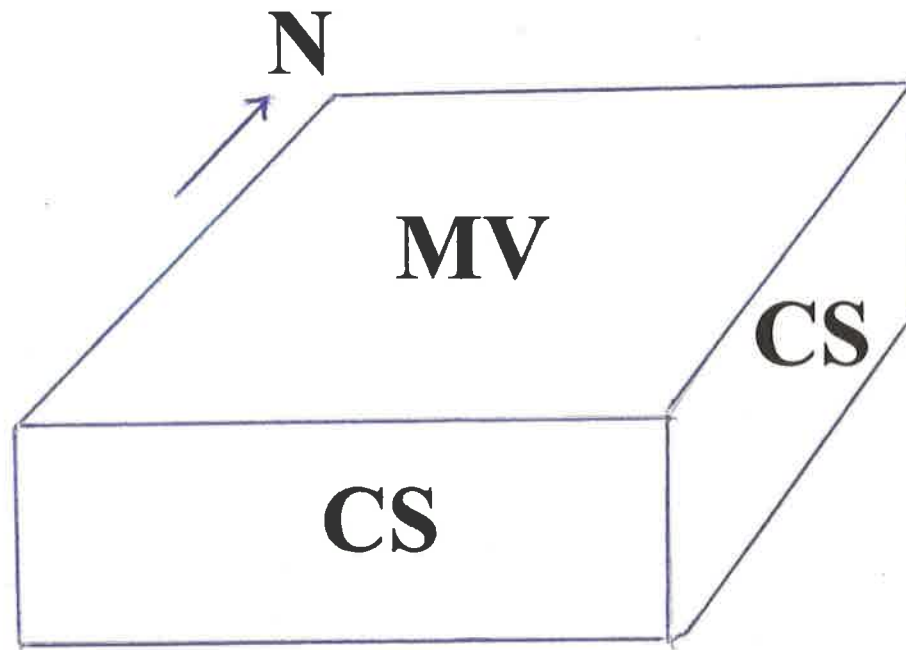


The block diagram



- 1. You must have a direction indicated, usually north. Otherwise you can't do strike and dip direction.**
- 2. MV--map view, aerial view, top view. For block diagrams, this is considered flat. Strike and dip symbols are put only (I repeat only) on the map view. Hypothetical horizontal plane is part of the definition of strike. This is it.**
- 3. CS--cross section, side view. Could be front cross section or south cross section. Could be side or east cross section. A cross section can be any direction in a block diagram.**
